Number of Days of Exposure per month (A)	Risk Factor (B)	SSS Contribution (C)	Monthly Hazard Pay (BxC)
15 days or more	1.00	Php 2,400.00	Php 2,400.00
8-14 days	0.80	Php 2,400.00	Php 1,920.00
7 days or less	0.60	Php 2,400.00	Php 1,440.00


The payment of hazard pay shall be charged against the local funds.

This order shall take effect immediately.
